Qualifications for the Military Wall of Honor for the Leland, MS School District

March 11, 2024

In order to qualify for the Wall, the nominee must have lived in the Leland School District (Attachment 1) for a length of time and served honorably in the military as defined herein.

In order to qualify as a veteran of the uniformed military service for the Military Wall of Honor, the service member must have proof of one or more of the following qualifications and must have been discharged under honorable conditions:

- 1. Served 180 consecutive days or more on active duty (not including active duty for training) in the U.S. military (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, or Space Force). Service members who died while in an active duty status are eligible.
- 2. Served on Active Duty during a period of war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge was authorized.
- 3. A Guardsman or Reservist called to active duty by the President for purposes other than training.
- 4. Special conditions as established by the Veterans Administration such as disabled or died while on active duty or active duty for training.
- 5. Served six or more years in the National Guard or Reserve and resigned or retired under honorable conditions. Service members who were disabled or died while in an active Guard or Reserve status (ADT, IDT, AT or AD) are eligible.
- 6. Considered a veteran by the Veterans Administration and received an honorable or equivalent discharge.
